

CHARTERED ORGANIZATION RELATIONSHIPS AND CUB SCOUTING

The Great Salt Lake Council adheres to the policies of the Boy Scouts of America. The Great Salt Lake Council also supports the chartered organizations in their right and responsibility to set procedures in implementing BSA policy. *The Great Salt Lake Council does not interpret chartered organization policies.*

1. General questions relating to chartered organization policies should be referred to the literature published by that organization.
2. Specific questions relating to unit procedures should be referred to the Institutional Head or the Chartered Organization Representative responsible for Scouting. (See the publication *The Chartered Organization Representative*.)

- Fund Raising
- Pack Budgets
- Restricted Activities
- Tiger Cubs
- Religious Emblems such as Faith in God, Parvuli Dei, God and Me, and others
- Primary Presidency Responsibilities
