- ❑ Be at least 16 years old.
- ❑ Be (or become) certified as an American Red Cross or BSA Lifeguard.
- ❑ Strong swimming ability required; previous lifeguard, boating, swimming experience helpful.
- ❑ Be (or become) a registered member of the Boy Scouts of America.

The aquatics instructor must be able to function in a rugged environment. This may include hiking, working at high altitude, bending, carrying at least 50 lbs, and the ability to work in bad weather.

Desired Characteristics:

- ❑ Mature judgment
- ❑ Ability to work under pressure
- ❑ Good interpersonal skills, especially in dealing with boys.
- ❑ Safety conscious
- ❑ Enthusiastic

Job Duties:

Under the direction of the camp aquatics director:

- ❑ Teaches aquatics related rank advancement classes including swimming, lifesaving, canoeing, and rowing.
- ❑ Serves as a lifeguard.
- ❑ Assists in the set-up and takedown of the camp waterfront.
- ❑ Assists aquatics director with their duties.
- ❑ Keeps an advancement record of youth participating in the rank instruction.
- ❑ Maintains a safe water front environment, including safe swim defense and safety afloat guidelines.
- ❑ Performs the duties of a program staff member as described in the Program Staff Member job description.
- ❑ Other duties as assigned by the camp director.
