CUB SCOUT AND BOY SCOUT DAY CAMP**

Job Qualifications

1. Must at least 14 years old by the opening of camp.
2. Must be a registered member of the Boy Scouts of America
3. Scouting background is desirable, but not required.

The program staff member must be able to function in a rugged environment. This may include hiking, working at high altitude, bending, carrying at least 50 lbs, and the ability to work in bad weather.

Desired Characteristics

- Safety Conscious
- Enthusiasm

Program Duties

1. Provides instruction and assistance for the assigned activity programs.
2. Serves as a guide or host for a group of Cub Scout or Boy Scouts.
3. Participates actively in campfire skits and songs, camp ceremonies and other program activities as assigned.

General Camp Duties

1. Assist with general camp clean-up and sanitation, including trash and latrine facilities.
2. Participate in the camp set-up and takedown.
3. Keep assigned program area clean and free from litter and debris.
4. Ensure the safety of campers by being an example of and enforcing camp safety rules.
5. Assist campers by answering questions and providing camp information.
6. Other duties as assigned.
