**ARCHERY DIRECTOR
BOY SCOUT RESIDENT CAMP**

Job Qualifications:

- ❑ Be at least 18 years old.
- ❑ Be (or become) a registered member of the Boy Scouts of America.
- ❑ Be (or become) trained by a National Camping School-trained Shooting Sports Director. (Training provided)

The archery director must be able to function in a rugged environment. This may include hiking, working at high altitude, bending, carrying at least 50 lbs, and the ability to work in bad weather.

Desired Characteristics:

- ❑ Mature judgment
- ❑ Safety-conscious
- ❑ Good interpersonal skills, especially in dealing with teenagers
- ❑ Enthusiasm

Job Duties:

- ❑ Supervise the camp archery range.
- ❑ Ensure safe range conditions, including adequate flagging, signage, and layout.
- ❑ Ensure proper care of archery equipment, including adequate cleaning and appropriate storage.
- ❑ Supervise merit badge instruction to ensure that each Scout receives appropriate learning opportunities.
- ❑ Submit inventories of archery equipment to the camp program director.
- ❑ Comply with BSA shooting sports guidelines as found in the National Camp Standards of the Boy Scouts of America.
- ❑ Other duties as assigned by the camp director or program director.
