**ASSISTANT COOK  
BOY SCOUT RESIDENT CAMP****Job Qualifications:**

- ❑ Be at least 16 years old.
- ❑ Be (or become) a registered member of the Boy Scouts of America.
- ❑ Previous food service experience strongly preferred.
- ❑ Have (or obtain) a food handler's permit.

The assistant cook must be able to function in a rugged environment. This may include hiking, working at high altitude, bending, carrying at least 50 lbs, and working in high temperatures.

**Desired Characteristics:**

- ❑ Mature judgment
- ❑ Ability to work under pressure
- ❑ Detail oriented
- ❑ Good interpersonal skills, especially in dealing with teenagers.
- ❑ Safety conscious

**Job Duties:**

- ❑ Complete assigned duties in the preparation, cooking and clean-up of each meal.
- ❑ Ensure that food is stored in accordance with accepted practices and local, state and federal guidelines.
- ❑ Keep kitchen floors, prep areas and equipment clean and free from hazards.
- ❑ Assist the head cook in his or her duties.
- ❑ Other duties as assigned by the camp director.

In some cases, the head cook will also serve as the food ordering agent for the camp. In these cases, additional duties would include: put together the daily food order; ensure that the order is placed on time through the council's food distributor; work with the food distributor to stay within the food budget.
