The handicraft director must be able to function in a rugged environment. This may include hiking, working at high altitude, bending, carrying at least 50 lbs, and the ability to work in bad weather.

Job Duties:

- ❑ Ensures that the handicraft program operates in accordance with established BSA standards and local or state regulations, if applicable.
- ❑ Maintains an inventory of the assigned equipment..
- ❑ Leads the staff in the set-up and takedown of the Handicraft area.
- ❑ Trains staff in merit badge skills as needed..
- ❑ Develops and coordinates the Handicraft program in conjunction with the camp program director.
- ❑ Ensures that merit badge instruction meets BSA standards for safety and merit badge requirements..
- ❑ Other duties as assigned by the camp director.
