- ❑ Be at least 18 years old; minimum 21 years old strongly preferred.
- ❑ Be (or become) certified as an Outdoor Skills Director at National Camping School.
- ❑ Have skill with knots, compass, maps, lashings, and outdoor survival practices.
- ❑ Be (or become) a registered member of the Boy Scouts of America.

The outdoor skills director must be able to function in a rugged environment. This may include hiking, working at high altitude, bending, carrying at least 50 lbs, and the ability to work in bad weather.

Desired Characteristics:

- ❑ Mature judgment
- ❑ Ability to work under pressure
- ❑ Detail oriented
- ❑ Good interpersonal skills, especially in dealing with teenagers.
- ❑ Safety conscious
- ❑ Enthusiastic

Job Duties:

- ❑ Supervise the outdoor skills staff.
- ❑ Ensures that the outdoor skills program operates in accordance with established BSA standards and local or state regulations, if applicable.
- ❑ Maintains an inventory of the assigned equipment..
- ❑ Leads the staff in the set-up and takedown of the Outdoor Skills area.
- ❑ Trains staff in merit badge skills as needed..
- ❑ Develops and coordinates the outdoor skills program in conjunction with the camp program director.
- ❑ Ensures that outdoor skills instruction meets BSA standards for safety and merit badge requirements.
- ❑ Leads the weekly survival outpost camp. Ensures safety of campers and adherence to BSA, state and federal policies, including fire restrictions.
- ❑ Other duties as assigned by the camp director.
