**SKI BOAT DRIVER**  
**BOY SCOUT RESIDENT CAMP**  
(Bear Lake Aquatics Base only)

**Job Qualifications:**

- ❑ Be at least 21 years old.
- ❑ Be (or become) certified as an American Red Cross or BSA Lifeguard.
- ❑ Strong swimming ability required; experience with boating and waterskiing encouraged.
- ❑ Be (or become) a registered member of the Boy Scouts of America.

The ski boat director must be able to function in a rugged environment. This may include hiking, working at high altitude, bending, carrying at least 50 lbs, and the ability to work in bad weather.

**Desired Characteristics:**

- ❑ Mature judgment
- ❑ Ability to work under pressure
- ❑ Detail oriented
- ❑ Good interpersonal skills, especially in dealing with teenagers.
- ❑ Safety conscious
- ❑ Enthusiastic

**Job Duties:**

Under the direction of the camp aquatics director:

- ❑ Drives the water ski boat.
- ❑ Ensures that the boat and ski equipment are in safe working order.
- ❑ Ensures that the waterski program operates in accordance with established BSA standards and local or state regulations, if applicable.
- ❑ Maintains an inventory of the ski equipment, including watercraft, PFDs, ropes and skis.
- ❑ Assists in the set-up and takedown of the camp waterfront.
- ❑ Maintains and makes minor repairs on the ski boat(s) as needed.
- ❑ Works as a member of the camp aquatics staff and lifeguard when not driving the ski boat.
- ❑ Other duties as assigned by the camp director.
