

**2008 Jamboral
Position Description
Events Staff Chairman**

Successful operation of the Jamboral depends on scouts and leaders being at the right place at the right time and also not being in the wrong areas. The members of the Jamboral Events Staff serve to assist in creating and maintaining appropriate boundaries and borders for individual district areas and for the various events of the Jamboral. They also assist all participants in having a better experience.

1. Working with the District Jamboral Chairman and District Key Three, recruit and train a District Jamboral Events Staff (The events staff may include mature youth staff if properly trained and uniformed at all times)
2. Maintain district area boundaries.
3. Assist with unit and district area management and security including:
 - a. All scouts return to their district area following the fireworks show.
 - b. Provide staff escort for any scout approved (by Events Staff Chairman) to be out of their area after 11:00 PM.
4. Assist the Council Jamboral Events Staff in maintaining proper boundaries, control and security for key Jamboral events including:
 - a. Performances
 - b. Fireworks
 - c. Unit check-out
 - d. Others as requested by their district or by the council events staff.
5. Hosting of dignitaries and special guests.
6. Participate in Council and District Jamboral Committee training and committee meetings as requested.
7. Help build the excitement for a great Jamboral and 1 million hours of service.
