Sign up online at www.saltlakescouts.org or complete and mail in your unit's Jamboral 2008 application to the Council Service Center, Great Salt Lake Council, 525 Foothill Blvd, SLC, UT 84113-1199, by July 19, 2008. **Registration is \$25.00 per person, Scout or leader. Early-Bird registration is \$20.00 per person prior to Saturday, July 19, 2008.** If you do not know how many in your unit will be attending, you can hold a spot by sending in your registration form with a \$25.00 deposit. **You must pay the balance of your fees before July 19, 2008, to receive the early registration discount.**

Location

The Salt Lake County Equestrian Park and Events Center is located at 2051 West 11400 South, South Jordan, UT. Salt Lake County has provided the Park for us to enjoy. This beautiful facility has grassy fields and extensive parking. During this event we will be guests of the Equestrian Park. Please keep the "**Outdoor Code**" and "**Leave No Trace**" in mind and show our best Scout camping manners and behavior.

Salt Lake County Equestrian Park and Events Center

The Salt Lake County Equestrian Park and Events Center sits on approximately 120 acres and is located nearby, and has several major traffic arteries for convenient access.

The Events Center is capable of seating up to 3,000 spectators in fixed seats. Although the arena can accommodate as many as 5,000 spectators with the use of floor seating, the park

also features five outdoor arenas ranging from a warm up area to a lighted 5,000 seat rodeo arena.

The park is located just six minutes from I-15. Take the 10600 South off ramp and proceed West to 2200 West. Turn left and head South approximately 3/4 mile following the signs.

Medical Information

Tour Permit

Because the Jamboral is an overnight event, all units must fill out a LOCAL TOUR PERMIT to be approved by the Great Salt Lake Council office prior to your departure. Remember, tour permits should be filed two weeks in advance of a scheduled activity. Save yourself time by planning ahead to beat the rush.
