SUGGESTED PERSONAL EQUIPMENT CHECKLIST

ONLY OFFICIAL SCOUT UNIFORM AND PARTS ACCEPTABLE - Be prepared for an overnight hike as well as living in camp.

Please Label EVERYTHING

REQUIRED ITEMS

- A positive attitude
- Current/Medical form/Consent form
- Mess kit, cup, fork, knife, spoon
- Flashlight, with spare cells, bulb
- Hand soap and container
- Hydration pack or water bottle
- Insect repellent (non-aerosol)
- Pack (for over-night experience)
- Personal first-aid kit (very small)
- Raincoat/poncho, coat, jacket
- Shoes (suitable for hiking, no open toed)
- Scout BSA or NYLT hat*
- Sleeping bag/blanket(s)/ sleeping mat
- Toothbrush and toothpaste
- Towel, comb, deodorant
- Underwear (7)
- Uniform pants/shorts, belt
- Uniform shirt Class A
- Uniform shoulder tabs (red, orange, green)
- Uniform stockings

PROVIDED ITEMS

- Class B NYLT Tee Shirt
- Neckerchief Slide
- Neckerchief
- NYLT Handbook

ITEMS YOU SHOULD BRING

- Change of clothing (emergency use)
- Change of shoes
- Ground cloth (waterproof)
- Pajamas/camp warmer
- Pens and pencils (2)
- Sewing kit (very basic)

OPTIONAL ITEMS

- Camera
- Extra prescription eyeglasses
- Foam pad
- Lip salve (not optional)
- Personal Scouting equipment
- Religious book(s)
- Small Camping Pillow
- Sunglasses
- Sunscreen (not optional)
- Watch
- Trading Post money

All boys MUST be in official uniform before moving to the campsite. Pack must be used for getting gear from the bridge or outpost camp to the campsite. Participants must not use suitcases, footlockers or trunks at the campsite. Normal prescribed patrol equipment will be issued.

* Participants may purchase NYLT hats at Parents' meeting, at camp or use any official BSA hat.

NOTE - PLEASE BE PREPARED FOR COLD WEATHER. An extra blanket to go in your sleeping bag, pad and a winter coat are desirable items to have. The Uintas can be terribly cold at night – even in the summer. It is not uncommon to have either rain or snow (or both) during the course.

INSIGNIA - Before coming, see that all badges and insignia are properly placed on uniform.

Valuables – Please do not bring valuable items to camp. For this reason we request that you DO NOT bring non-disposable cameras, any portable music players, cell phones, pagers, jewelry, binoculars, collectable scout gear, expensive camping gear or any other valuable or non-replaceable item. Please MARK all items with your son's name on them.

Money – We will have a store (Trading Post) where your son can purchase candy, small craft items, patches and a NYLT Hat. Spending money is totally optional. We will provide all of the food and craft items. Please do not send more than \$20.00. Small Bills (1's & 5's) are appreciated.
