Events and activities:

- Ice fishing (on your own – ice is 6-12” thick. Perch and trout are biting)
- Camp gadget contest
- Klondike sled race and winter activities
- Sledding (sledding hill is over a mile away)



Food: Troops are to provide their own dinner, breakfast, and lunch

Preparation:

- Teach boys winter camping skills – it WILL be cold
 - Camping Merit Badge requirement 3, 5, 6
 - (2 sleeping bags, change of clothes, foam pad, warm tent, etc.)
- Teach boys winter survival skills and hypothermia treatment
 - First aid and Wilderness Survival Merit Badges
- Prepare a duty roster and plan your meals
 - Camping MB requirement 4, Cooking MB
- Practice with your Klondike Sled
 - build one if you don't have one

- Camp Gadget
 - Develop a scout made camp gadget and show it off. Prize for the most useful gadget.
 - Gadget must be made by scouts and must be demonstrated by one or more scouts

- Camp stoves OK

Facilities:

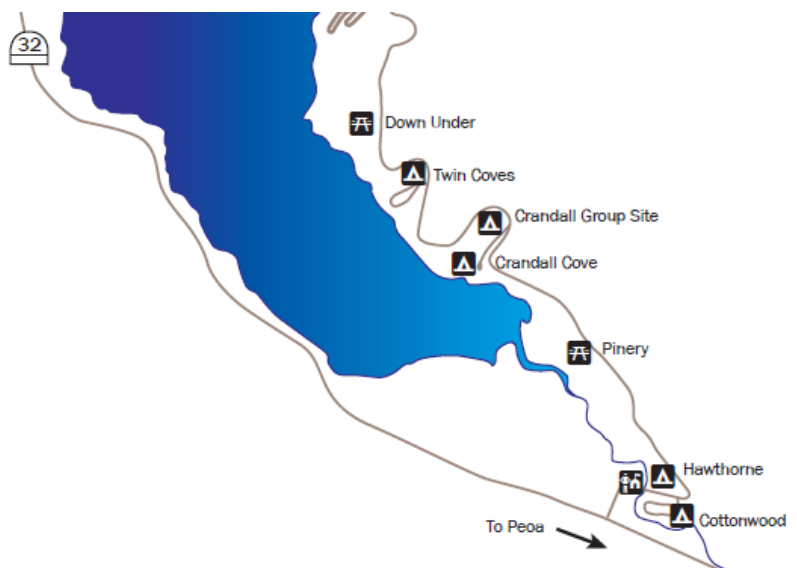
- Vault toilets, parking for cars or trucks, small pavilion

Location:

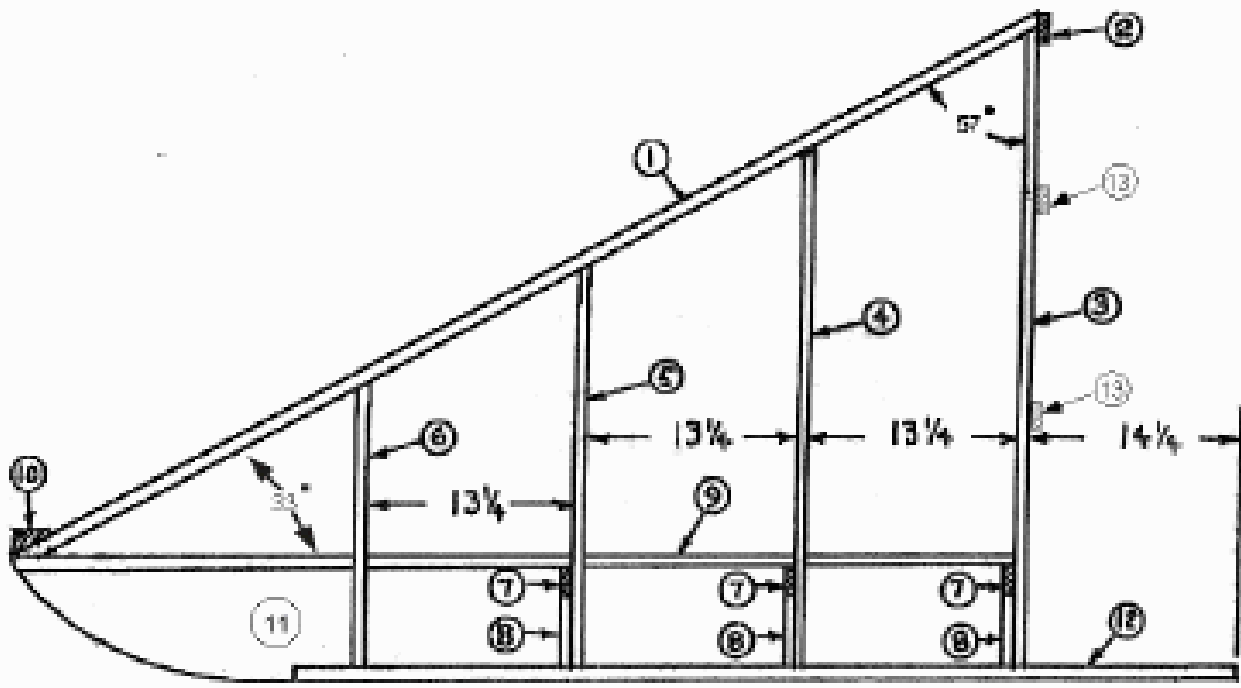
- Rockport state park
