### COOPERATION IDEAS

**Water-Spoon relay:** Have a bucket on both sides of the course for each team as well as a spoon for each team. First person dips spoon into filled bucket and runs to the end of the course and empties their spoon into empty bucket, then runs back to other side and gives spoon to next in line. Team with most water in bucket at the end of the course wins!

**Water balloon - towel toss:** Each team has at least 4 members with two beach towels and 1 water balloon. They take turns tossing it to the other half of the team who catches the water balloon in their towel and tosses it back and so forth. The last team to break their balloon wins.

**Relay games:** Remember, any type of relay game or a game that the boys must work with someone else would be great for this month's theme!
